



CBTN 2024 Scientific Summit Abstract Submission Guidelines

- All abstracts must be submitted in English.
- Multiple abstracts from an institution are welcome
- The presenting author assumes full responsibility for the contents of the abstract and must ensure that all other authors have approved the abstract before submission.
- The author will be required to register for the meeting
- Please do not submit the same abstract with different presenting authors.

Preparation of Abstracts

Title: Abstract title can contain a maximum of 250 characters.

Author(s): First and last names, institutions, and e-mail addresses of the authors must be fully indicated correctly and in the right order.

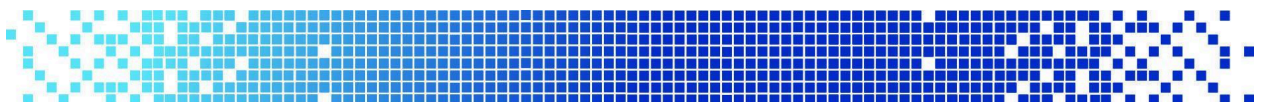
Institution(s): The institution(s) of the authors should be indicated fully with the “department” and “institution” names while avoiding any abbreviations such as Dept., Inst., Hosp., etc. The institution and city should be written in lower case while the initials of each word are written in capitals (e.g. The Hospital for Sick Children).

Abstract text: Abstract text should not exceed 300 words. The title of the abstract, authors’ names, institutions and key words are not included in this limit.

The abstract should have four sections:

- Objective
- Material and Methods
- Results
- Conclusion

Upon submitting your abstract an e-mail including the “Abstract Number” and “Title” of your abstract will be sent to the contact author who has submitted the abstract.





Evaluation Process and Acceptance Letters

All submitted abstracts will be scored the Scientific Committee Chairs following which the draft program will be drawn up. While scientific merit is the most important factor in evaluating an abstract, the program will also take into account other factors such as the topic, geographic representation etc.
